

THE DAVID YANIR TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIPS 2014

The David Yanir Foundation for the Advancement of Colorectal Surgery in Israel is pleased to announce the appointment of several travelling fellows for the duration of one week in the UK.

This year's fellowships are again supported by The John Furman Fund of the Israel Britain and Commonwealth Association.

The one week travelling fellowship will take place in London. The successful candidates will take part in the Basingstoke M25 colorectal course on 12th-14th March 2014. (Can be viewed on Internet site)

The course will be preceded by a two day colorectal surgical attachment in one of the central London Hospitals. The programme will take place between the 9th- 16th March 2014.

The group will travel on Sunday the 9th March and return on Sunday the 16th March 2014.

Candidates must apply in writing by 25th November 2013 enclosing a CV in English with a passport photograph.

Candidates must be qualified in general surgery

Candidates must be fluent in English.

Preference will be given to surgeons who have undertaken the Israeli Fellowship in colorectal surgery and are Members of the Israeli Colorectal Society.

Particular attention will be given to young surgeons who are contemplating further colorectal specialisation, and to surgeons in peripheral hospitals.

Candidates will be expected to provide a detailed report of their experiences in English on their return, as well as write appropriate letters of thanks to their sponsors.

The foundation will expect a financial contribution of 2500 shekels from the candidate's parent surgical department or hospital
